WAGE ROLLBACKS

We are urgently asking all City members to attend the <u>September 21st City of Edmonton Unit Meeting</u>, on Zoom or in person at the CSU 52 Office!

Your Bargaining Team will be present to discuss the City of Edmonton's proposal to **roll back your wages to pre-2018 levels.**

Our best estimate of the City of Edmonton's offer of an economic increase is 0% for 2021, 1% for 2022, and 2% for 2023.

Add that to the 0% increases in 2019 and 2020 and the resultant is 3% over a 5-year period.

The City has already moved and will be moving the membership from 33.75 hours/week to either 36.9 or 40 hours/week.

The move to 36.9 hours results in a 3.1% decrease in your hourly rate.

The move to 40 hours results in a 5.5% decrease in your hourly rate.

The net of these numbers means that those moved to 36.9 hours/week will be making 0.1% less per hour than they did in 2018, and 2.5% less per hour for those moved to 40 hours.
