President's Message



The lovely fall weather continues into October. I hope you are all taking advantage of these summer-like temperatures and enjoying our lovely city.

September was a very busy month for CSU 52. On the 14th, we joined in

unity at Churchill Square for the Red Shirt Campaign with intentions to show City Council and their negotiating team our solidarity and support. We were joined by various other unions including the Pipefitters Union, CUPE, AUPE, NASA, the Alberta Federation of Labour (AFL), Friends of Medicare, Edmonton & District Labour Council (EDLC), IBEW, and the Boilermakers Union. Estimates of over 300 employees turned up in red shirts, some carrying signs that said, "Work Life Balance", "Devoted to our Members and Community", "No to More Hours - Less Pay", and "Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) - No Zeros". The next planned rally will be on October 13th. We expect the Red Shirt Campaign will continue with our EPCOR bargaining unit in the fall as well. We have four of our five bargaining units currently engaged in negotiations: City of Edmonton, EPCOR, Edmonton Public Library, and Capital Power. The fifth bargaining unit, TELUS World of Science - Edmonton (TWOSE), will prepare for bargaining later this year.

With bargaining, Bill 32 issues, Covid, higher interest rates, and rising inflation, these last few years have been very difficult for our members to try and keep their heads above water. We are working very hard to bring fair and equitable agreements to each of our bargaining units, but we need your involvement and support. If you need advice or information, please call our office.

Longtime CSU 52 Labour Relations Officer Amber Andersen retired earlier this year and I want to take this opportunity to thank her and wish her luck in the next phase of her life. Amber provided dedicated service to CSU 52 and its members and she will be sorely missed.







A campaign to support negotiations for both the City of Edmonton and Edmonton Public Library bargaining units began over the summer. CSU 52 started by organizing people to be Red Shirt Captains in their work areas. Our captains have been busy organizing the membership about our collective actions ever since.

First, we asked everyone to sign the signature of support: "I will only accept a contract with wage increases every year and will stand in solidarity with my bargaining team!" To date, we have collected over 770 signatures – if you haven't done so, please let your voice be heard!

Then we held a series of campaign actions. We had pizza parties where we made our "I Support My Bargaining Team" buttons for members to wear. Please wear them proudly in your workplace.

We also had volunteers come out and phone-tree our members to make sure they were aware of the campaign and to spread the word to wear red at work.

Our first rally was held on September 14th - it was a great success and our show of solidarity was attention grabbing! We made it into The Sun and The Edmonton Journal news. Our "Sea of Red" made certain that everyone knows we mean business.

Not everyone could attend the rally downtown, so we offered virtual opportunities for members to participate.

Members are downloading virtual CSU 52 avatars for their online profiles. We also began a social media campaign alongside our mobilization campaign: #RedShirts #WeAreCSU52

Many of our members came together in their networks to show up to the rally. We also had allies, friends, and family show up in support. The Alberta Federation of Labour, the Edmonton & District Labour Council, NASA, Progress Alberta, UA Local 488, Friends of Medicare, and others (let's not forget about our one Boilermaker friend, too!). Our Coalition partners were also there. Blake Desjarlais (MP - Edmonton Griesbach) came to support us and gave us a great boost on his social media as well. The support we received across the spectrum of our community is reassuring that people support civic unions in getting a fair deal!
