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RE: A dispute between Civic Service Union 52 affecting The Edmonton Public Library – Board File No. SL-01529

This acknowledges receipt of the Declaration of Strike Vote from the Civic Service Union 52 (the "Union") showing the results of the vote. We enclose a copy of the Declaration for the Employer and Mediation Services' information.

The Board confirms the employees voted in favour of taking strike action against their Employer. Section 77(1) of the *Labour Relations Code* stipulates that a strike vote is only valid for 120 days. If no strike occurs during this period, a new vote is required.

No strike can take place unless at least 72 hours notice is given in writing to the Employer as required by Section 78(1)(a). The notice must include the date, time and initial location of the strike. After written notice is served, the Mediator must be notified as required by Section 78(1)(b).
