5.02 (a)(ii)	For nomination to the Board of Directors, the nominee must have Shop Steward and/or Committee experience and have attended a minimum of six (6) regularly scheduled General Meetings and/or Shop Steward Training Sessions and/or Unit Meetings of the Contractual Unit to which the nominee belongs, during the period of October 1st of the preceding year to September 30th of the current year, and must submit a completed nomination form signed by three (3) Active Members, by commencement of the meeting in which nominations are made. Special Meetings are excluded for the purpose of determining qualification.	For nomination to the Board of Directors, the nominee must have Shop Steward and/or Committee experience and have attended a minimum of six (6) regularly scheduled General Meetings and/or Shop Steward Assembly and/or Unit Meetings of the Contractual Unit to which the nominee belongs, during the period of October 1st of the preceding year to September 30th of the current year, and must submit a completed nomination form signed by three (3) Active Members, by commencement of the meeting in which nominations are made. Special Meetings are excluded for the purpose of determining qualification.
